The AT&T Performing Arts Center is seeking Teaching Artists (TAs) to join its Education & Community Outreach team. TAs are professional theatre artists and educators who facilitate workshops and residencies for students and school teachers of all backgrounds and abilities. Candidates should be equal parts artist and educator and have a passion for engaging others in the art of theatre. The Center is specifically looking to hire TAs with experience in acting, music direction, and choreography.

This is a part-time, contract position. Work fluctuates based on season and TA availability.

TA responsibilities may include, but are not limited to:

- Leading in-school musical theatre residencies for 3rd-5th grade students in Dallas ISD public schools.
- Teaching theatre workshops on a variety of topics for various ages, as assigned.
- Facilitating professional development workshops for classroom teachers and school administrators.
- Participating in ongoing professional development with the Teaching Artist ensemble.
- Contributing to curriculum development, as needed.

Required:

- Demonstrates skills and professional experience in musical theatre, including: choreography, directing, performance, music direction, and design
- Experience working with a wide variety of populations and ages

- Strong classroom management skills
- Willingness to travel to schools across Dallas
- Excellent collaborative skills; willing and able to team-teach with fellow TAs
- Strong time-management skills and dedication to established work commitments
- This position requires regular afterschool availability between 3:00-5:30 pm from January-May 2019. Candidates must also be able to attend four full days of paid training from November 26-29, 2018 between 9:00 am -6:00 pm.

Preferred:

- An undergraduate or advanced degree in Theatre, Education, Educational Theatre, Applied Theatre, or other related field
- Experience working with English Language Learners
- Ability to converse in languages other than English
- Experience working on the production team of a musical with children or adults
- 3+ years of experience working as an expert in your artistic discipline

All applicants will be considered without attention to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, veteran or disability status.
